The Mobile Unit Driver & Engineer will report to the Director of Venue Relations & Field Engineering, and will be responsible for, but not limited to all aspects of driving and maintaining the truck and trailer that comprise the mobile unit, integration at venues, nodes and other locations based upon need, as well as setting up and operating The Switch’s Mobile Unit Trailers in support of sporting and special events.

Principal Responsibilities:

- Drives Company’s truck-trailer to and between job sites/destination per client event schedule. Park and power unit at event location. Ensure generator is fully fueled and the spare gas can is full.
- Assist Director of Venue Relations & Field Engineering with all documentation and depiction of relevant technical facilities in each site to facilitate upgrades and improvements, as well as having a complete understanding of the current and potential future transmission methods.
- Interface with all site contacts on an ongoing basis and as needed to maintain a productive working relationship. Serve as the primary customer interface for all video and data services originating at venues.
- Work with Operations to manage on-site work for troubleshooting/replacement of equipment, including visits to city nodes when necessary. Develop an understanding of each site’s telecommunications infrastructure.



- Extended and extensive travel to establish, maintain and augment the existing network architecture and new equipment integration.
- Assist in diagnosing customer local circuit issues to ensure the highest quality of service.
- Work within timelines for projects, based upon event schedules.

Qualifications/Skills:

- Excellent driving skills and clean Motor Vehicle Record.
- Experience driving a truck-trailer combination, and ability to back and park trailer in tight confines.
